



Welcome to CLAREMORE EXPO CENTER RV PARK

The Claremore Expo Center RV Park is an adjacent part of the Claremore Expo Center, Arenas and Stall Barns. It is located close to all the amenities of the Expo Center itself as well as nearby Will Rogers Memorial Museum, Rogers State University and the J. M. Davis Gun Museum. The Claremore Expo Center annually hosts dozens of local, regional and national events ranging from sports, recreation shows, trade shows and countless equestrian events.

Campground Rules and Policies

Registration and Payments

All site rent must be paid in advance. **NO REFUNDS.**

Renter must be 18yrs or older with a valid state issued photo id.

We accept cash, credit cards and money orders ONLY.

See Camp Host or Expo Center Office as soon as you arrive to fill out a Guest Registration form and make your payment.

If you arrive between the hours of 8PM and 8AM please fill out the guest registration form completely and place with your payment in the dropbox.

If you are not checked out by 6PM on departure date then you will be charged for another night.

Driving and Parking

The speed limit in the RV Park is 10mph and 15mph in other areas of the Expo Center.

Do not drive vehicles across empty RV sites.

Do not park on the grass. All tow and towed vehicles are to be parked either in front of or behind the RV at your site.

RV's must be in good, well kept working condition.

Only horse trailers that are a living quarters unit may be parked in the RV park. All other horse trailers must park in the designated areas.

Parking is strictly at your own risk. Claremore Expo Center does not accept any responsibility for your vehicle, its contents or for personal injury or property damage sustained by you or your guests.

Children

Parents are responsible for the conduct and safety of their children.

Children under the age of 12 years old are not permitted in restrooms, showers or other facilities without adult supervision at all times.

Pets

Per the City of Claremore Pet Policy, pets 5 months of age and older need to be neutered or spayed and long term tenants (over 30 days) must have pets registered with the City of Claremore. Permits are available at the City Clerk's office at City Hall. A copy of this permit must be provided to the Expo Center Office.

Additionally potentially dangerous breeds or any dogs in excess of 30pounds are not permitted in the RV Park or on park property. *(Unless you have a service animal with proper documentation or animal is personally approved by management.)*

Pets must be on a leash and accompanied by their owners at all times.

Pets are not to be left tethered unattended outside or allowed to bark at neighbors or passersby.

The "dog walk" on the south side of the park is the designated area for you to take your pets. Bags and trash containers are there as a convenience for you to immediately pick up any animal droppings and dispose of them correctly.

At no time should animal droppings be left anywhere in or around RV sites.

You will receive a warning and may be subject to additional fees.

Pets are not allowed in RV Park buildings or other campsites.

If your pet acts in an aggressive manner at any time, you will be asked to remove it from the premises immediately. Claremore Expo Center Management reserves the right to alert Claremore Animal Control

Sites

Sewer connections must be secure with screw in or air tight donut collars.

Trash is to be bagged and deposited in the refuse containers provided.

Campfires and other open fires are not permitted. Only the use of gas and charcoal grills is permitted.

Outdoor rugs and mats may not be placed on the grass.

The use of generators is not permitted.

No smoking in campground buildings or facilities. Please keep cigarette butts off the ground.

Respect the privacy of your neighbors and do not trespass on other campsites. Quiet time is 10:00PM to 8:00AM.

The use of loud, foul, threatening, or vulgar language and threatening or reckless behavior will not be tolerated and is grounds for immediate eviction.

Damage or destruction of any property will be paid for by the responsible party.

Accidents should be reported immediately to the Camp Host and the Expo Center Office.
